
Why **female** students and researchers?



### **Structured Mentoring Program with Three Key Elements**



- (1) **MENTORING** > Individual advice by a mentor
- (2) Tailored EVENTS PROGRAM (workshops, talks and other formats)
- (3) PEER-NETWORKING with your colleague mentees





### **Structured Mentoring Program with Three Key Elements**



### (1) MENTORING: Individual advice by a mentor

- Interdisciplinary, one-to-one mentoring by an experienced FAU scientists (or from affiliated institutions)
- No subject-specific mentoring > complementary to professional supervision
- Focus: Questions related to career planning and development in science





### Mentor is an independent and neutral person!

- No hierarchical relationships & role conflicts
- Exchange in a protected space, not related to your professors and other students; allows to raise more intimate questions

# (2) Tailored EVENTS PROGRAM

(workshops, talks and other formats)

- Focus on soft skills, personal development and working techniques
- Professional trainers with a track record in the academic field
- Including an introduction to your role as a mentee (mandatory)
- Online & personal meetings





### **Structured Mentoring Program with Three Key Elements**






- (3) PEER-NETWORKING with your colleague mentees
- Exchange with your peers at events &
- independently of the official program

Self-organised meetings (e.g. regulars table, activities)
Platform for exchange withing the group (e.g. WhatsApp)

### **Motivation of participants**

- Clarification of personal career goals (within and outside of academia)
- Support with decision-making processes and strategic career planning

### **Motivation of participants**

- Getting to know **role models**, especially female leaders
- Expanding competencies
   (soft skills in communication, leadership, time management, etc.)
- Sense of belonging and support (in often male-dominated environments)
- Empowerment through sharing experiences with other women in similar situations

Insight into structures and processes at university

New impulses from your mentor and your peer-mentees

Enhancement of professional and social competencies

Chance to build networks with people, who are in the same stage of qualification

### **Personal requirements**

#### **Proactivity:**

Mentoring means that you are in the driver seat to come up with questions and share your ideas and doubts.

It is up to you to ask your mentor for a meeting. It is you who sets the agenda.

#### Your time and implication:

Your schedule is busy at university, but it pays off to invest time into workshops and meetings.

To make your mentoring a success, you need the stamina to be involved throughout the program period of 9 months.

#### Your openness:

You should like to get feedbacks and to learn.

#### Your willingness to share:

Networks are a success factor throughout any career. Start to build them now with your peer mentees!





### **Formal requirements**

You need to have a **formal connection** to the Faculty of Engineering or the Faculty of Sciences. You should have a **strong preference for further academic qualification**.
