FAUmentoring ARIADNErewi





- Is a free of charge career mentoring program for Female Early Career Researchers at the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law who are interested in pursuing an academic career.
- The aim of ARIADNErewi is
 - to increase the proportion of women at higher qualification levels in research and,
 - to support women in their doctoral and postdoctoral studies, with the long-term goal of increasing the number of female professors.
- ARIADNErewi is part of the target agreements to increase the proportion of women in research.
- The program is currently in its seventh round. A program cycle has a duration of 18 months.

The program is aimed at **Female Early Career Researchers** who are pursuing a **career** in **research** and are dealing with **questions** such as:

I am conducting promising research, but do I have enough self-confidence to make my mark in academia?

Can I balance my personal life with the demands of a research career?

Which strategic decisions pay off early on in order to pursue a long-term career in research?

One-to-One-Mentoring

- Program coordinator matches mentee with a mentor (without hierarchical relationship)
- Interdisciplinary mentoring (no subject specific mentoring)
- Mentee and Mentor individually coordinate their mentoring relationship
- Approximately 6 10 meetings during the program period

The mentee receives individual advice on strategic and practical issues relating to academic careers.



Networking





Establishing and expanding your own academic network

- Within the Mentee-Peergroup,
- Across ARIADNE(all) and with ARIADNE alumnae
- A framework program consisting of an official kick-off and closing event and workshops at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of the mentoring program
- After a first get together there will be 2 organized networking meetings in the beginning of the program. Followed by selforganized peer networking meetings



Who may participate?





Female Early Career Researchers from the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law pursuing a career in research.

- Female doctoral candidates,
- Female postdoctoral researchers,
- Female habilitation candidates at the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law and,
- Female students at the final stage of their degree at the School of Law

- are interested in a further career in research,
- demonstrate commitment and willingness to take initiative in the mentoring process,
- are motivated to participate in accompanying workshops and (selforganized) networking meetings, and have the capacity to do so, and
- have a formal connection to FAU.

- **Insight** into the rules and structures of the scientific community.
- Further development of your identity as a scientist.
